

6 RED IPAD RULES

- **When we are not using the iPad, you will hear us say “Apples Up.” This means the screen should be face down.**
- **When you are using your iPad in class, your iPad should be FLAT on the desk at all times or using classroom iPad props**

1. These iPads are for learning. It is a privilege to use them.
2. You are to use only your iPad, unless given specific permission by your teacher.
3. When using the iPads, your volume should be turned off unless otherwise directed by the teacher. Messaging must be turned off during school hours.
4. When using your iPad, you must be on the correct site, app, etc..., or you will be considered off task and will receive consequences accordingly.
5. The camera is not to be used for any reason unless given explicit permission or direction by your teacher.
6. YOU are responsible for maintaining YOUR iPad. This means your iPad is to be fully charged each school day. It is YOUR responsibility to keep your iPad with you at all times. If you leave your iPad anywhere, YOU are responsible for anything that happens to it (damage or lost).
7. When using the iPad you are to follow all school and 6 Red rules and expectations. Any expectations or rules broken will result in consequences, and may result in the loss of your iPad.
